(Limited to only one Secondary Presenter)
- C. Attach a CV or resume for each presenter to the abstract. Include educational and professional qualifications **related to the proposed topic.**

- A. List up to three significant presentations within the last five years

Provide NO MORE than a one-half page, single spaced description of your proposed presentation, detailing the content of the presentation.

- Intermediate appropriate for the Dermatology Nurse with experience
- Advanced appropriate for the Advanced Practice Nurse

E. Two sentence synopsis that could be used in the program brochure if selected to present

F. Objectives

- No more than three

- Behaviorally stated (e.g. words such as define, describe, list, identify, demonstrate)
- Reflective of content
